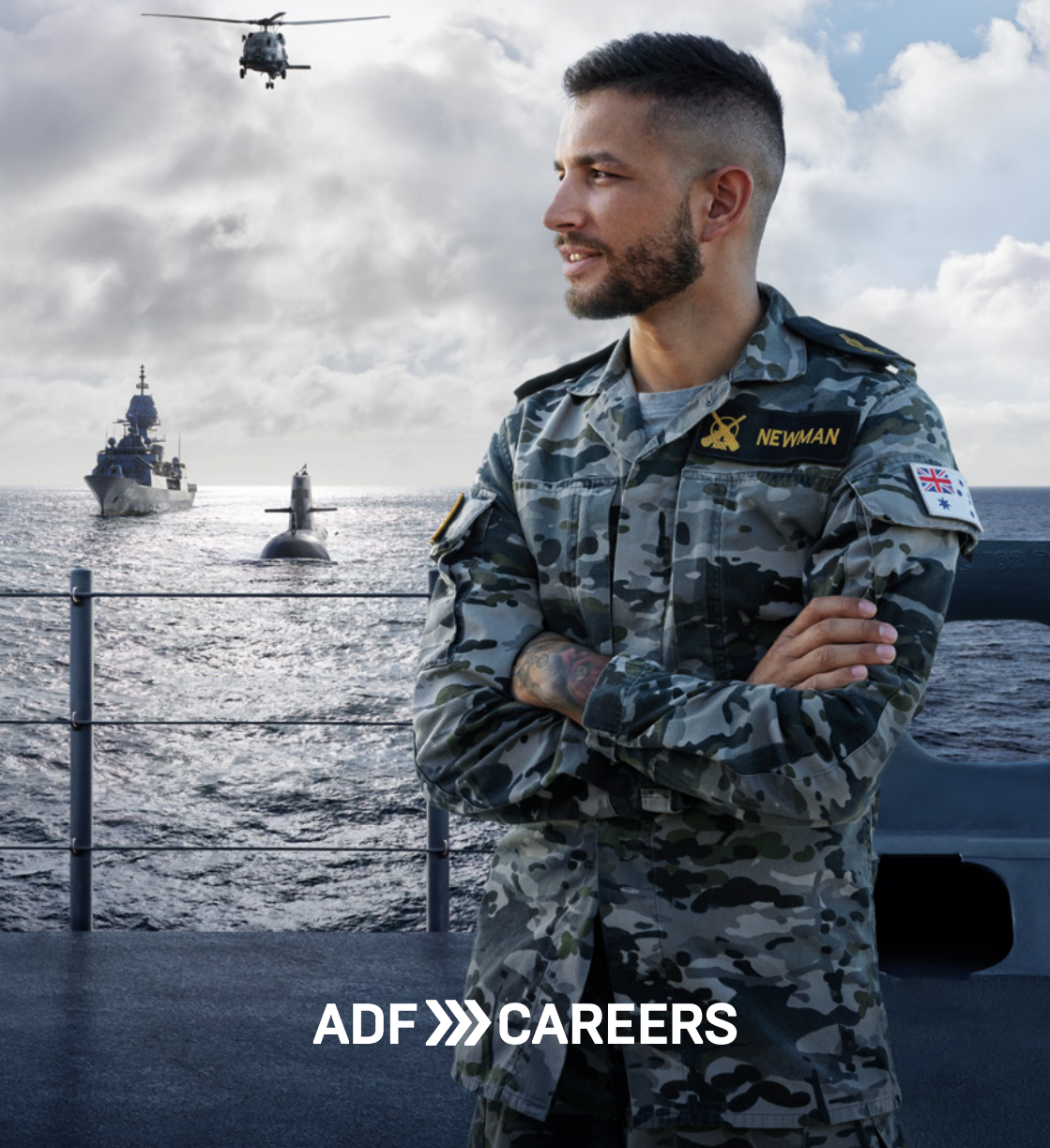

TRADES

ELECTRONICS TECHNICIAN

Maintain, diagnose and repair satellite and radar systems, missile and gun systems, underwater systems like sonar, fire control systems and communication systems, onboard ships and ashore.

FULL TIME RESERVE

ELECTRONICS TECHNICIAN SUBMARINER

Work onboard submarines maintaining, repairing and diagnosing underwater sensors, combat and weapons systems, navigation aids, electronic warfare systems and more.

FULL TIME RESERVE

MARINE TECHNICIAN

Maintain and operate engineering machinery and systems, ensuring the ships remain fully operational and mission capable. The role is split into three trade specialisations and on application you will choose from either electrical, hull or propulsion.

FULL TIME RESERVE

MARINE TECHNICIAN SUBMARINER

Maintain and operate submarine machinery, weapons and engineering systems. The role is split into two trade specialisations and on application you will choose from either electrical or propulsion.

AVIATION

AIRCREW

Take to the skies in a Navy helicopter and undertake a variety of challenging, yet rewarding, missions like search and rescue, anti-submarine operations, and aerial weapon support.

AVIATION TECHNICIAN

Ensure MH-60R Seahawk helicopters are kept in peak working order by maintaining, repairing and overhauling aircraft systems, equipment, transmissions, gear and structures, onboard ships and ashore.

AVIATION SYSTEMS TECHNICIAN

Maintain, monitor and repair helicopter navigation systems, sensors, weapons and anti-submarine systems in MH-60R Seahawk helicopters, at sea and ashore.

FLIGHT DECK MARSHALL

Manage incoming and outgoing helicopters from ship flight decks and make preparations for safe aviation operating environments.

COMMUNICATIONS, IT & INTELLIGENCE

SONAR OPERATOR

Operate the high-tech sensors that provide essential intelligence to your commanders, working in the uniquely supportive environment of a submarine.

COMMUNICATIONS OPERATOR

Be the communications link exchanging sensitive and classified information for Navy operations and missions.

NETWORKS OPERATOR

Manage, operate and maintain advanced ICT networks to protect information and keep your ship connected and secure.

COMMUNICATION NETWORKS OPERATOR SUBMARINER

Be the subsurface communications link operating radios and IT systems to exchange classified information onboard submarines.

INTELLIGENCE ANALYST - LINGUIST

Learn another language and work in a highly classified environment to intercept, analyse and share information from communication transmissions to support intelligence missions.

CYBER OPERATOR

Find hidden messages, identify threats, respond to cyber incidents and keep networks protected in this highly classified role.

INTELLIGENCE ANALYST - SYSTEMS OPERATOR

Intercept and analyse signal transmissions to support intelligence operations to inform military strategy and gain tactical advantage.

ELECTRONIC WARFARE OPERATOR

See what can't be seen by intercepting, identifying and analysing electronic signals passing through the air to provide your team with advanced warning of potential threats and unknown entities within the ship's area.

ELECTRONIC WARFARE SUBMARINER

Operate submarine surveillance systems to analyse, identify and monitor murmurs and emissions from unknown vessels and entities.

HYDROGRAPHIC SURVEYOR

Collect and analyse data about the ocean and sea floor using surveying equipment to acquire and interpret data that assists with navigation, environmental protection, economic development, security and more.

IN ADDITION TO CARRYING OUT THE DUTIES ASSOCIATED WITH YOUR EVERYDAY ROLE, YOU'LL BE GIVEN THE OPPORTUNITY TO ENGAGE IN THE GENERAL TASKS PERFORMED ONBOARD NAVY SHIPS AND SUBMARINES.

THESE COULD INCLUDE:

- Joining boarding parties tackling illegal activity
- Helping land helicopters in a flight deck team
- Being the first aider for your section
- Performing man overboard exercises
- Assisting with at sea replenishments
- Assisting with vessel berthing
- Being a member of an emergency response team

Your Navy journey starts at Recruit School, where you'll learn to be a resourceful and multitasking sailor while improving your fitness through sports and exercise. Among other subjects you'll learn how to:

- Live and work with a close-knit team
- Use weapons
- Perform ceremonial and drill duties
- Firefight
- Repair and control floods
- Perform basic ship duties
- General service knowledge
- Perform first aid
- Survival at sea training

INITIAL EMPLOYMENT TRAINING

Following graduation from Recruit School you'll start learning the skills of your specific role, under the guidance of expert Navy trainers.

This could take you to one or more locations across Australia, as well as to sea on Navy vessels.

Navy training is both highly regarded and ongoing, and will equip you with skills and qualifications that will benefit your job prospects wherever life takes you.

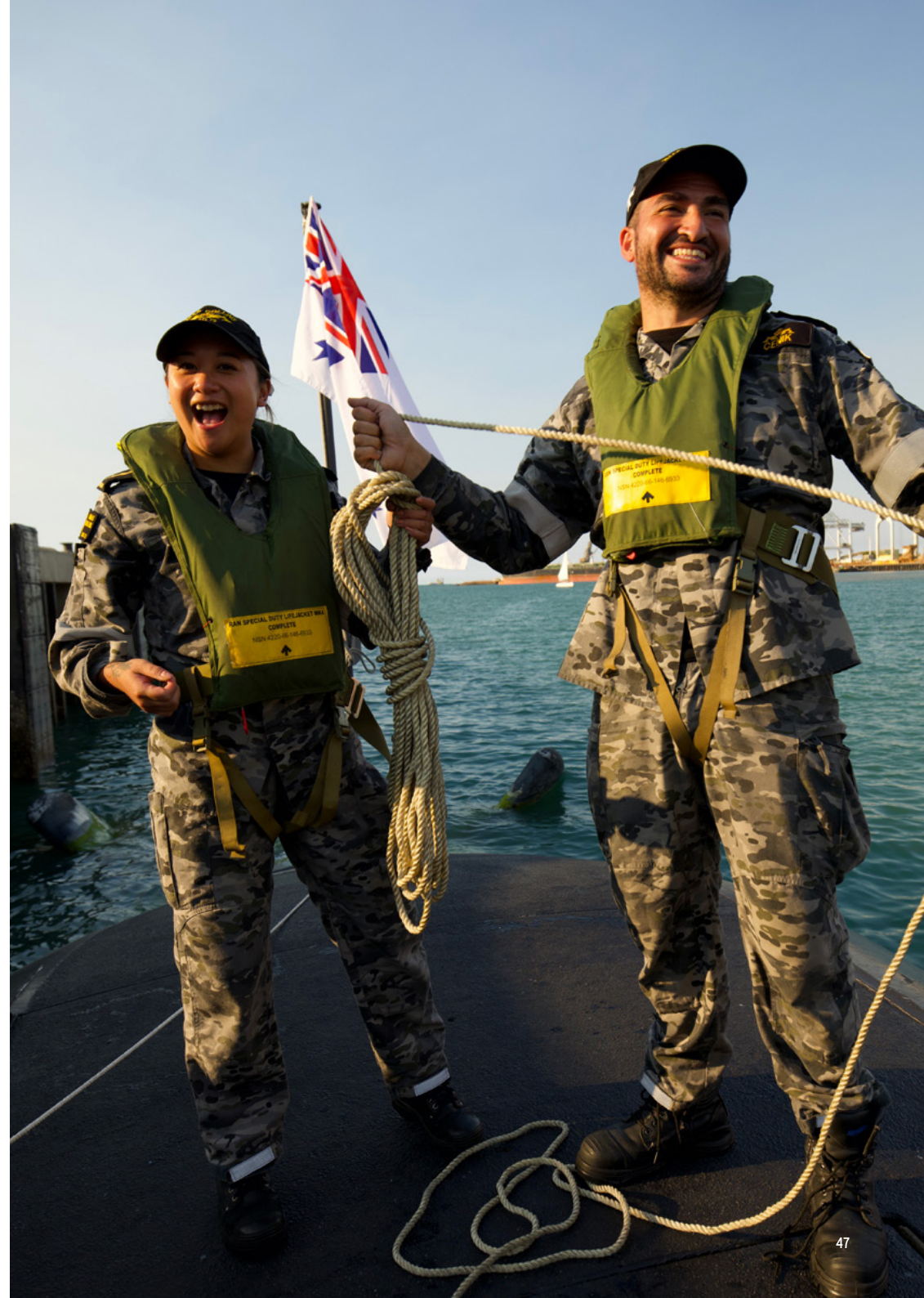

FITNESS

GET PAID TO KEEP FIT

A reasonable level of fitness is required. Regular exercise prior to joining will set you up for success as it is an important part of training and service life.

Once you join, the Navy will support your health and fitness with physical training instructors, chef-made meals, access to gyms, sports, PT sessions, and conditioning programs.

A Pre-entry Fitness Assessment (PFA) is a requirement for Navy Divers which consists of 30 push ups, 25 sit ups and a shuttle run to level 10.1.

Once you join, you will be required to pass a basic swim test, consisting of a 3-metre platform jump, a 50-metre swim, a 10-metre underwater swim and a 15-minute treading water exercise.

SIX STEPS TO BECOMING A NAVY SAILOR



1 CHOOSE A ROLE OR APPLY WITHOUT A SPECIFIC JOB IN MIND
Find full details of each Navy Sailor role at adfcareers.gov.au

2 APPLY ONLINE, CALL 13 19 01 OR VISIT YOUR LOCAL ADF CAREERS CENTRE
You'll need to provide your contact details, academic achievements and job preferences.

3 ATTEND A *YOUR OPPORTUNITIES UNLIMITED (YOU)* SESSION
Talk about the role(s) with a Careers Coach at your local ADF Careers Centre, take a Job Opportunities Assessment and complete a medical questionnaire.

4 ATTEND AN ASSESSMENT SESSION
Undertake a medical assessment and attend psychological and job interviews to have your leadership, teamwork and other areas of potential assessed.

5 COMPLETE A PRE-ENTRY FITNESS ASSESSMENT
You may need to complete a fitness assessment that consists of completing a number of specific exercises to a certain standard.

6 ATTEND ENLISTMENT DAY
Have a final medical check, join family and friends for the welcome ceremony, then head straight to Recruit School and an exciting new career in the Navy.
